



PhD position (m/f/d) Global Political Sociology with focus on the Global South (3 years +1) At the Chair Sociology in Africa at the University of Bayreuth (remuneration according to remuneration group 13 TV-L 50%)

Your responsibilities will include supporting the Chair in research and teaching in the area of Global Political Sociology/International Political Sociology with a focus on Africa and the Global South, as well as in cross-cutting tasks at the Chair. The position is limited to three years with possible extension for one year.

Job Description:

- Conduct innovative independent research with a focus on Global/International Political Sociology as it relates to the Global South.
- Collaboration on joint projects and research proposals and participation in the further development of research and teaching in the aforementioned focus area.
- Teaching courses per term of 2.5 SWS (one seminar per term on average)
- Contribution to administrative tasks at the Chair including science communication and academic self-administration

Required:

- Degree in Sociology, Political Science/International Relations, Peace and Conflict Studies, Global Studies, African Studies with a social science focus or related subjects completed with good to excellent results.
- Very good knowledge of written and spoken English, good knowledge of German is an advantage but can also be acquired in the first two years.

Also desirable are:

- Knowledge and interest in one or more of the following areas: Global/international political sociology; sociology/anthropology of international organizations, politics and sociology of transnational networks and social movements; postcolonial and decolonial approaches in the social sciences.
- Regional expertise in Africa, or in transnational actors and processes in Africa and/or the Global South, preferably non-Western/South-South.
- Very good knowledge of qualitative methods, interest in methodological innovation and digital methods
- High level of teamwork and communication skills as well as an independent and thorough approach to work
- Interest in interdisciplinary collaborations

This is a fixed-term position according to WissZeitVG and serves to foster academic qualifications. The duration of the employment relationship depends on the legal and personal requirements. In all other respects, the employment requirements stipulated in BayHSchPG apply.
